Prosecutor Jennifer Webb-McRae announces:

On January 23, 2026, a Cumberland County Jury returned a verdict of guilty against Defendant, Edwin Ramos-Rosado, age 42 of Millville for Murder in the first degree in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3a(1). The Jury also convicted this defendant on related weapons offenses – specifically second degree Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4a(1) and Unlawful Possession of a Weapon in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5b(1).

Jury selection began on January 6, 2026. The State presented evidence that on November 2, 2022, members of the Millville Police Department and Detectives from the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office responded to the 400 block of North 4th St., Millville for a gunshot victim. The victim, Ramy Garcia, was pronounced deceased at the scene. Investigation revealed that Mr. Ramos-Rosado shot the victim before fleeing the scene. He was later apprehended by the Bellmawr Police Department.

Sentencing is scheduled for March 23, 2026. The defendant faces 30 years to life in New Jersey State Prison for the Murder, of which he must serve at least 30 years or 85% of his sentence, whichever is greater.

The Honorable Niki Arbittier, J.S.C. presided over the trial. The prosecution was represented by Assistant Prosecutors Lindsey Seidel and Madison Weber. The defendant, Edwin Ramos-Rosado, was represented by Emily Bell, Esquire.
