One Juvenile Killed and One Injured in Atlantic City

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ — On January 5, 2024, at approximately 10:48 pm, the Atlantic City Police Department responded to the 3300 block of Atlantic Avenue in Atlantic City in reference to a disturbance involving numerous individuals and possible shots fired. Officers arrived and located two juvenile males on the sidewalk and roadway who had gunshot wounds. The first juvenile is a 16-year-old male from Atlantic City identified as A.C. He was treated at AtlantiCare Medical Center, city division for a gunshot wound to the leg and released from the hospital after a few hours. The second juvenile is a 14-year-old male from Atlantic City identified as F.G. He was transported to AtlantiCare Medical Center, city division for a gunshot to the head. He succumbed from his injuries on January 6, 2024 at 3:27pm. The cause and manner of death are pending an autopsy by the South Regional Medical Examiner's Office.

This incident is currently being investigated by the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit and the Atlantic City Police Department Violent Crimes Unit.
