

Investigation Continues Into 2022 Pleasantville Shooting Death

MAYS LANDING, NJ - The Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office's Major Crimes Unit is requesting the public's assistance as it continues to investigate the shooting death of Craig Wyatt, which occurred in Pleasantville on October 4, 2022.

That evening, at approximately 10:47 p.m., Pleasantville police responded to a report of shots fired on the 200 block of 4th Avenue. Upon arrival, responding officers located Craig Wyatt, 55, unconscious and unresponsive outside a residence. He was pronounced deceased on scene.

The investigation had been ongoing since that time. ACPO is urging the public to come forward with any information that may be of assistance in identifying and prosecuting the responsible person or persons. In some instances, even the smallest details may prove vital to solving a case and bringing closure to a victim's loved ones.
