Police Investigating Two Deceased Bodies Found Inside Borgata Hotel Room

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ – On November 23, 2025, at approximately 4:55 p.m., the Atlantic City Police Department responded to the Borgata Hotel Casino and Spa in reference to two deceased individuals in one of the hotel rooms. Officers arrived and located female Baoyi Bowie Zheng, 36, of Staten Island, NY, and male Wei Guo Liang, 68, of Brooklyn, NY, both deceased inside of the room. Autopsies on both revealed that Zheng died from a broken neck and Liang by self-inflicted stab wounds.

This incident is currently being investigated by the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office's Major Crimes Unit and the Atlantic City Police Department.
