

*****UPDATED*** Police Investigating Shooting Death in EHT**

EGG HARBOR TWP., NJ – On Monday, April 13, 2026, officers from the Egg Harbor Township Police Department responded to a call of a shooting at the Excelcare Rehabilitation Facility, located at 6818 Delilah Road, Egg Harbor Twp., NJ, at approximately 6:00 a.m.

After an investigation by the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office's Major Crimes Unit, in conjunction with the Egg Harbor Township Police Department, it was determined that Brandon Alexander, 35, of Minotola, NJ, shot and killed his estranged wife, Victoria Alexander, 38, also of Minotola.

Based on the investigation thus far, it appears Mr. Alexander waited in the Excelcare parking lot for Victoria Alexander to arrive for work. Victoria Alexander was employed there as a nurse. Once she arrived, Mr. Alexander pulled up and blocked her in. He then entered her vehicle and left two suicide notes on her dashboard. A food delivery truck driver asked Mr. Alexander to move his vehicle. At that time, Mrs. Alexander took an opportunity to exit her car and run into the building. Mr. Alexander followed her into the building where he shot her several times and then shot himself. Victoria Alexander was pronounced deceased at the scene and Mr. Alexander was taken to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center – City Division. Earlier this morning, Mr. Alexander succumbed to his self-inflicted injuries.
