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Morris County Prosecutor Robert Carroll and Acting Chief of Detectives Mark Castellano announce that Donald J. Reddin, 34, of Wharton, has been charged by the Morris County Prosecutor's Office in connection with alleged obstruction of a criminal investigation. Reddin was employed as a Rockaway Township Police officer at the time of the offense, and is currently suspended without pay.

Reddin is alleged to have provided privileged information to the subject of a criminal investigation. It is alleged that on March 12, 2026, Reddin informed the subject not to leave his residence due to police activity in the area, which negatively affected the execution of a search warrant during an investigation.

On August 31, 2026, Reddin was charged by the Morris County Prosecutor's Office with one count of fourth degree Obstruction of a Government Operation, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-1A; and one count of third degree Conspiracy to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance (CDS), in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2A(1), by way of a summons complaint. He was processed and released pending a court appearance.

A criminal complaint is merely an accusation. Despite this accusation, this defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
