TWO DEAD AND FOUR INJURED FOLLOWING A SHOOTING IN THE AREA OF ROSA PARKS BOULEVARD AND GODWIN AVENUE IN PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

May 11, 2026

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Department Officer-In-Charge Patrick Murray announce that on May 10, 2026, at approximately 8:26 p.m., members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Rosa Parks Boulevard and Godwin Avenue on a reported shooting. When officers arrived, they found six individuals with gunshot wounds. The victims were transported to Saint Joseph's University Medical Center. Two victims, a 43-year-old male from Paterson and a 29-year-old male from Paterson were pronounced deceased. The remaining victims, all residents of Paterson, are in stable condition.

This investigation is active and ongoing. More information will be released when it becomes available.
